- Participate in extracurricular activities (i.e. sports, music, art, etc.)
- Be self-aware (display good sportsmanship, make healthy choices, and be self motivated)
- Have a keen interest in being a contributing member of the Oak Grove School community

TO APPLY

- Student must complete a 1-3 page essay about your interests outside of school and why you believe you will be a positive community member.
- Parents must complete a 1-3 page essay on why you have chosen Oak Grove for your student and how, as a family, you will be a positive addition to the Oak Grove School community.
- Please submit these to the Admissions Office no later than **April prior to the year applying**. You will be notified no later than May 15th regarding the disbursement of the scholarship funds.

A student will continue to receive scholarship funds on an annual basis as long as the student continues to:

- Demonstrate sincere academic effort.
- Participate as an active community member, determined by community service, a positive attitude and overall involvement—student council, school events, etc.
- Exhibit good character as determined by staff, faculty and peers.
