4-Year High School Scholarship



To Apply for the Art of Aesthetics Scholarship:

- Complete an online application for Oak Grove School
- Complete the Financial Aid Application
- Submit teacher evaluation forms or community member recommendation and transcripts
- Student: Write a 1-2 page essay describing a performance or piece of work you are most proud of completing
- Parents: Write a 1 page narrative on why you have chosen Oak Grove for your student, and how, as a family, you will be a positive addition to the community
