Both Preschool and Kindergarten

Please label everything with your child's name:

- Reusable, squirrel-proof lunch-box
- Reusable water bottle
- Extra changes of clothes and shoes for cubby in a cloth bag or backpack
- Closed- toe shoes (preferably that children can easily manage on their own)
- Sun hat (optional)
- Rain gear (boots, jacket, rain pants or overalls)
- 1 Family photo
- 1 Baby photo
- 1 Current photo of student



Buying new school supplies is an exciting experience for children. Parents, please purchase only the supplies on the list below. Teachers will supply the rest of the needed items.

1st Grade

- Extra changes of clothes for cubby in a ziplock bag
- Sketch pad or drawing journal
- 1 large pencil case that will fit inside the desk and can contain all of the following items :
 - 1 box of colored pencils
 - 1 box of 24-count crayola crayons
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 pair small scissors
- 1 box of markers
- Set of watercolors
- Photo of student and student's family

Please note that some Homeroom supplies will be needed for art class, ie: markers, colored pencils, etc. If you have any questions about purchasing supplies please do not hesitate to contact your teacher.



2nd Grade

Please label everything with your child's name.

- Extra changes of clothes for cubby in a ziplock bag (short sleeve and long)
- 4 paper (not plastic) pocket folders in the following solid colors: red, yellow, green, blue (without 3-ring holes)
- 2 single-subject spiral notebooks with wide-ruled lines
- 1 sketch book
- 1 LARGE pencil case (I encourage you to re-use the one from last year) that will fit inside the desk that can contain the following items:
 - a manual pencil sharpener
 - 1 box of 10 count classic color crayola markers
 - 1 box of colored pencils
 - 1 box of 24-count crayola crayons (regular size)
 - 2 large glue sticks
 - 1 box of #2 pencils
 - 2 large pink pearl erasers

3rd Grade

Please label everything with student's name or initials:

- 1 shoebox for creating a math box
- 1 pencil box (we encourage you to reuse your one from last year!)
- 3 pink pearl erasers
- 1 box sharpened colored pencils
- 1 box of colored markers
- 1 single subject spiral notebook in the color green
- 1 sketchbook
- 1 pencil sharpener

4th Grade

Please **label everything** with student's name:
Feel free to reuse items from prior school years.

- 1 large pencil case to contain the following items:
 - 1 box #2 pencils
 - Magic Rub eraser
 - Manual pencil sharpener
- 1 Mead Five Star spiral-bound notebook, with wide-ruled lines, 200 sheets, 10 ½ x 8 ½ . The notebook has five sections separated by four cardboard storage pockets, as well as a sturdy plastic front cover. [Five Star Five-subject with pockets, wide-ruled](#)
- 1 personal notebook (such as a composition book) for journaling and sketching.



5th Grade

 - Manual pencil sharpener
 - 3 erasers
 - 3 different colored highlighters
 - 3x3 sticky notes

ENGLISH

- Blank, lined notebook
- 1.5" binder
- 4 dividers with tabs
- Pens and/or pencils
- Highlighters
- Post-it notes

SPANISH

- 1" 3-ring binder with at least 5 dividers
- Blank, ruled, 3-hole punched writing paper
- Cover for textbook (For ideas, search 'Book Sox' on Amazon.com)
- Pens or pencils (what they prefer)

MATH

- Graphing calculator (Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus or TI-84 Plus CE preferred models)
- (1) ½" 3-ring binder or (1) pocket folder
- (2) spiral notebooks, graph ruled, 100 sheets
- Pencils and eraser

SCIENCE

- Pens, pencils, and eraser
- Colored pen for corrections
- Colored pencils
- (1) ½" 3-ring binder or larger
- Optional: share binder space with another subject using tab dividers
- Graphing calculator (Texas Instruments TI-84 preferred model -- same as used for math)
- Graph paper and lined paper
- Spiral notebook for class notes (optional, but strongly encouraged)

HISTORY

- (1) ½" or 1" 3-ring binder
- Lined paper (college ruled is best)
- (2) highlighter pens
- Pens & pencils
- Optional: dividers to separate old portfolios from current work

SPORTS
